- Make arrests in accordance with the law without violating human rights.

- Quickly respond to accidents, domestic violence, and other emergencies.
- Investigate crime scenes, collect evidence, and report findings.

- Educate and advise the community on safety measures.
- Conduct regular patrols to reduce criminal activity.
- Encourage partnerships with community organizations.

2. Communicate with the Public & Build Trust

- Treat everyone with respect and without discrimination.
- Mediate disputes to resolve conflicts peacefully.
- Promote positive relationships between law enforcement and the community.
- 3. Use Force Only When Necessary
- Apply force when necessary but within legal limits.
- Use de-escalation techniques before resorting to physical force.

- Use firearms only as a last resort.
- 4. Enforce Traffic Laws and Road Safety
- Conduct traffic stops to prevent accidents and violations.
- · Issue tickets and penalties for reckless driving.
- Respond to accidents and provide assistance when needed.
- 5. Report and Document All Actions
- Write detailed reports on incidents, arrests, and investigations.
- Ensure evidence is properly collected and secured.
- Provide testimony in court when required.
